VISION SCREENINGS



What does the screening entail?

- Vision Screenings examine Acuity, Pupils, Oculomotor & Tracking Skills, Color Vision, Eye Alignment, Ophthalmoscopy, Depth Perception, Accommodation (Focusing), and a RightEye exam (if necessary).

What is the cost?

- Screenings cost \$200/hour. We are able to screen approximately 15 students/hour.

How does the facility get results?

- Facility will receive a completed screening forms on the day of services, signed by the clinician, with referral steps if necessary.

What are the ages that you can screen?

- We screen individuals of all ages.

How long does a screening take?

- Screening times vary depending on age and the issues found, especially for children 4 and under (including infants). We estimate 5 minutes per screening for 5 to 7-year-olds and 4 minutes per screening for individuals 8 years and older.

What prep is needed for off-site screenings?

- We bring everything to your location!

What do we need from the location?

- Lists from each group to prepare forms.

HEARING SCREENINGS



What does the screening entail?

- Hearing Screenings include Pure Tone Screening at 3-4 frequencies per ear, Tympanometry and Otoacoustic Emissions Screening.

What is the cost?

- Screenings cost \$200/hour. We are able to screen approximately 20-25 students/hour.

How does the facility get results?

- Facility will receive a completed screening forms on the day of services, signed by the clinician, with referral steps if necessary.

What are the ages that you can screen?

- For Pure Tone Screenings, individuals must be old enough to respond, so 4-5 years old. For Tympanometry and Otoacoustic Emissions Screenings, individuals of all ages are able to receive the screening.

How long does a screening take?

- 2-4 minutes for the majority of individuals.

What prep is needed for off-site screenings?

- We bring everything to your location!

What do we need from the location?

- Lists from each group to prepare forms and 30 minutes to get set up in a private room; multiple outlets, and a table and chairs.
